Situated on Drury Lane in Covent Garden and London's famed West End, it is considered the landing-place for anyone who enjoys shopping, theatre, restaurants, bars, history and culture. At only yards from Leicester Square, a world-renowned entertainment destination, it is within walking distance of some of London's most sought out destinations, such as Trafalgar Square, National Portrait Gallery, Shaftesbury Theatre, and Piccadilly Circus. Drury Lane, home to the famous Muffin Man from the popular nursery rhyme, is also just a stroll away from the famous Strand, Central London's major thoroughfare running parallel to the River Thames from Trafalgar Square to Fleet Street, where several poets and authors like Charles Dickens and Virginia Woolf have lived.
